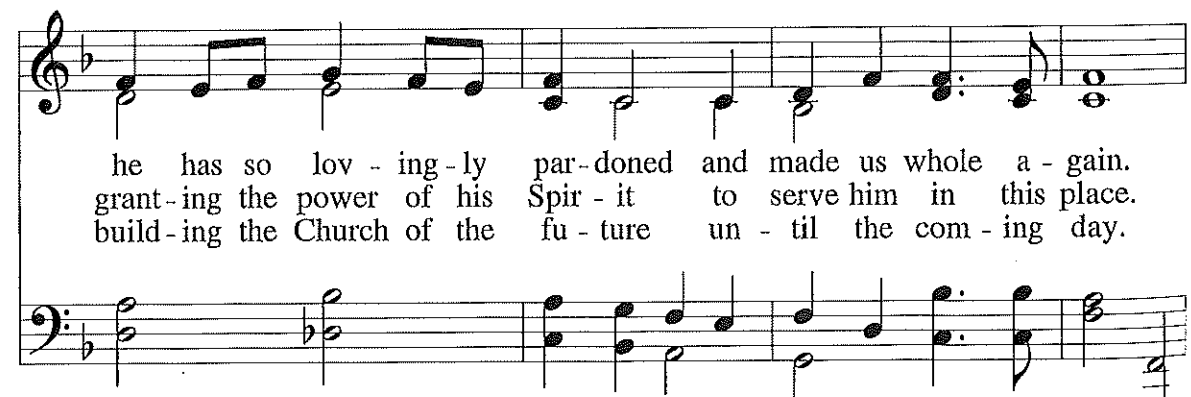
1 This is a time to re-mem-ber the great-ness of the Lord;

Face to Face

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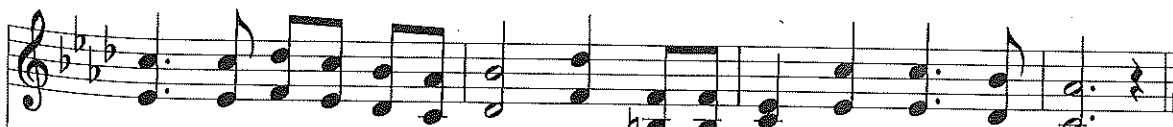
1 Face to face with Christ my Sav-ior, face to face-what will it be
